WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE RULE  
ENACTED IN 1954.

No person shall import a dog over six months of age into this state unless it is accompanied by an interstate health certificate including thereon a report vaccination for rabies. Such vaccination shall be conducted not more than 12 months prior to entry. Provided that when chick embryo vaccination is used, each vaccination shall be conducted not more than 36 months prior to entry. An interstate health certificate shall be executed by a veterinarian of the state of origin showing animals identified thereon have been inspected and no infectious diseases disclosed, and to include a rabies report.

REFUND OF ENTRY less \$10.00 will be given entrants of bitches entered in the Obedience upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian before 9 a.m. on the day of the trial that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the Trial.

DUPLICATE ENTRIES: We will make every effort to find duplicate entries, but once entry is processed, no refund will be made.

A Recording Fee of \$.50 plus \$3.00 service fee shall be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This recording fee is to be collected by the Show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Payment must accompany entry. RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. We are not able to process credit cards.

Hunting Retriever Class: Open to Dogs or Bitches that have (1) leg or more on their Junior Hunter through Master Hunter titles. Dogs and Bitches to be judged separately.

Veterans: (8 years and over) Veteran Class winners may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated at this event. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be exhibited in Veteran Classes and subsequently, in the Best of Breed Class at shows where judging does not proceed beyond Best of Breed. The Veteran may be neutered/spayed if and only if Veteran Class and Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Classes are the only classes entered.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Classes, for Best of Breed or Veterans. Stud Dog may be entered in the Stud Dog class only by paying the regular fee of \$28.00 or as an additional entry for \$18.00. A neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog. Produce for Get. A spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch. Entry fees \$28.00 for Brood Bitch only or \$18.00 as an additional class.

**SELECT DOG/SELECT BITCH:** To be awarded.

**JUDGES AWARDS OF MERIT:** will be given at the judge's discretion up to 10% of the Best of Breed entries.

## SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes is open to all Golden Retrievers who on the day of the show are 6 months of age but under 18 months. Champions of record are not eligible. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class of the show.

**HANDLER:** The handler of the Sweepstakes exhibit must be limited to the owner, breeder or member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date of the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. Professional handlers may also handle exhibits of which they are the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of the immediate family; however, it is recommended that a photocopy of the Registration Certificate for the exhibit accompany the entry for such an exhibit. A professional handler in Sweepstakes is defined as any person who receives remuneration for handling an exhibit not owned by them or a member of their immediate family.
